CHILD SEXUAL EXPLOITATION AND ABUSE, ONLINE SAFETY, DOMESTIC ABUSE

The Home Office have funded a redevelopment of our programme **Helping Hands**, a theatre in education programme on staying safe. The performances and workshop uses drama, discussion and appropriate humour to support schools' safeguarding education and help children aged 9 – 11 years old to stay safe in their interactions with others. This well researched programme draws on Loudmouth's decades of experience to help children to spot signs of abuse and know where they can go for support. Lesson plans are provided for teachers to build on the Loudmouth session.

The session provides a safe and gentle forum to learn how to spot signs of unsafe relationships and different forms of abuse including:

- Child Sexual Exploitation and Abuse
- Online safety
- Domestic Abuse

Loudmouth have been given permission by the NSPCC to include their popular PANTS rule. This simple and safe approach helps children to understand important safeguarding messages.
