SAFE AND SOUND

A report by the NSPCC showed that 25% of girls and 18% of boys reported some form of physical partner violence. 75% of girls and 50% of boys reported some form of emotional partner violence.

HOW WE CAN HELP

Safe and Sound a theatre in education programme that helps young people aged 12 upwards to spot the misuse of power and control in relationships, understand consent and safeguard themselves against teenage relationship abuse. The programme is accompanied by a term's worth of online lesson plans.

WHAT WE DO

Safe and Sound includes a drama and interactive workshop, available in different formats to suit your budget and timetable. We can work with a whole year group in one day for theme or drop down days or can do more targeted work with class sized groups. Learners will -

- have an increased empathy for people affected by abusive relationships including domestic abuse and teenage relationship abuse.
- have an increased ability to assess risk and identify abuses of power and control in relationships.
- have increased knowledge of what local services can do to support young people affected by abusive relationships or domestic abuse, e.g. Women's Aid, Brook, ChildLine.
