## Child Sexual Exploitation (CSE) Prevention & Awareness Programme for Young People

Working for Marcus is a safe and carefully structured CSE prevention and awareness programme written and run by Loudmouth Education & Training. Loudmouth are safeguarding specialists and have been running programmes on CSE since 1998.

Working for Marcus is a theatre in education programme that raises awareness of CSE. The programme explores grooming, online safety and consent and helps young people to spot the signs of grooming and where to go for support.

This theatre in education performance and workshop is part of a holistic education package that includes young people's sessions and pre and post-performance lesson plans. The programme is proven to have increased knowledge of and referrals to support services. Working for Marcus is also run as a highly popular training session for professionals.
